Stern Will, Mrs. Stern is a discretionary beneficiary of a "credit shelter" trust, the sole lifetime beneficiary of a "QTIP" trust, which is the beneficiary of one-half of Mr. Stern's residuary estate, and the direct outright beneficiary of the other half of the residuary estate.
